Wu Yee Children's Services is actively looking for team members to join our growing team. We are looking for passionate individuals interested in the critical work of helping children and families succeed throughout San Francisco. Below is a list of our current open positions.

Home Visitor – Full-time position – The Home Visitors enhances the role of parents as the primary educator of the child by providing comprehensive Early Head Start Services in the home setting. The Home Visitor visits parents and children in their homes and helps integrate education goals, and prepares children for success. Bilingual Cantonese/English required, two years of experience in early childhood development, family services or pediatric health. Associate's degree in Child Development, Social Work, Psychology or related field required. 12 units of Early Childhood Education required.

Family Child Care Specialist – Full-time position - The Family Child Care Specialist provides comprehensive Early Head Start services to children and families enrolled in the program. They provide support to the licensed Family Child Care providers in implementing Head Start at their centers. Bilingual and Bi-literate Spanish/English required, two years working with families and providers. Bachelor's degree in Social work, Child Development or related field required. Two years' experience working in Early Head Start/Head Start program or Child Development field.

Family Child Care Quality Network Consultant – Full-time position - The Consultant serves as an advisor and coach for 25 providers in the Family Child Care Quality Network. Consultant supports providers in the delivery of the San Francisco Quality Rating Improvement System (SFQRIS) including identifying goals and specific outcomes for their program, coordinating training, technical assistance and peer support to meet individual objectives and participation in ongoing program evaluation. Bilingual English/Cantonese or English/Spanish required. BA/BS Degree and 2 years of experience in Child Development or an AA Degree and 3 years of experience in the early care and education or related field serving children birth to 5 years and their families. Possession of 12 ECE units and/or Child Development Permit, 24 ECE units preferred.

Infant/Toddler Associate Teacher – Full-time position – The Associate Teacher assists in developing an engaging environment that reflects the cultural values and diversity of the children and families served. They provides consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children as a primary caregiver (teacher), and is also responsible for the safety, care, and supervision of all children in the classroom. Minimum of 1 year teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher’s permit and 3 infant/toddler units required.

Infant/Toddler Lead Teacher – Full-time position – The Lead Teacher creates an environment to reflect the cultural values and diversity of the children and families served. They are also responsible for the implementation of lesson plans and classroom activities, as well as ongoing monitoring of the environment and interactions in the classroom. Minimum of 2 years of teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Bachelor’s degree in Early Childhood Education with 6 infant/toddler ECE units and a Child Development Teacher’s permit is required.

Preschool Associate Teacher – Full-time position – The Associate Teacher assists in developing an engaging environment that reflects the cultural values and diversity of the children and families served. They provides consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children as a primary caregiver (teacher), and is also responsible for the safety, care, and supervision of all children in the classroom. Minimum of 1 year teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher’s permit required.

Resource Teacher – Full-time position – The Resource Teacher provides coverage and support to teaching staff. They will provide consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children, and is also responsible for the safety, care, and development of all of the children. 1 year of teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher’s permit required.

Family Advocate – Full-time and Part-time positions available - The Family Advocate (FA) promotes family wellness and parent involvement in the Early Head Start/Head Start Programs while acting as a liaison between classroom and home settings in the areas of health and family services. Manages a caseload of 35-45 families. Bilingual Cantonese/English and/or Spanish/English required, two years working with children or family services. Bachelor’s degree required, skilled in handling sensitive situations and the ability to support family needs.
