## MEETING NOTES

### San Francisco Budget and Advocacy

- Mayor released a proposed budget with significant cuts to some agencies and services.
- Supervisor Melgar proposed a resolution to expand investments in early care and education strategies to support San Francisco's children and families.
- Last year the City took \$30 million over 2 years from Baby Prop C interest to fill in the DEC baseline. All prop C funds have remained intact. This is a win for 2024.

### The Legislation & Public Policy Committee came to consensus on strategy:

- Start with - the ECE community does not support taking accumulated interest from Prop C dollars. This money should be used to intended beneficiaries. Propose spending on child care incentives for workers across the City to revitalize downtown.
- Be rational partners” in the budget process.

June 24 public comment day.

June 25 final approval of budget by BOS.
