- Questions about the amount of notice of switch between phase I and phase II

**DEC Facilities Strategy** (Graham Dobson)

- Graham gave update on the Child care fund
- Gave needs assessment overview
- Talked about there is a shift for Infant/toddler
- Spoke about LIIF priorities
- Take away – DEC must be included in any potential capital development planning. DEC's explicit funding priorities and criteria must be met to be considered for funding.

**San Francisco Budget and ECE – updates**

- Monica Walters shared an update.
- We had a win on baby prop C and thanked everyone.
- We will have some funding from the reserve ( interest income) that will be going to food insecurity of children, dcyf, etc .
- there was a last-minute push that allowed for more of that to be eligible when the reserve hits 100 million. But ECE advocacy coalition was able to maintain the threshold of the 300 million reserve
- 1.8 million from FRCs is going to be restored. – this is not new funding. This is restored funding.
- We still have more advocacy at the state

**Legislative Highlights** (Graham Dobson)

- There is an on-going process to look at the reimbursement rates
- Two year olds can be served in CSPP
