CPAC MEMBER VOTE:

Presentation: Child Care Facilities

Graham Dobson (DEC), Mona Malan (LIIF), Liz Winograd (LIIF) shared a presentation on the “San Francisco Child Care Facilities Fund”.

- LIIF is an international organization. There is a 25 year partnership between LIIF and SF ECE.
- Approx \$15 million a year that DEC is able to get out for facilities.
- Historically, HSA, DCYF and First 5 all worked together with contracts with LIIF.

San Francisco County Zip Code Priorities

Mona Malan

- As a Local Planning Council (LPC), CPAC is mandated to submit zip code priorities each year.
- The zip code priorities submitted in May 2024 are based on 2022 data.

Committee Chairs

Legislation and Public Policy- Margaret Brodtkin presented on the Together SF ballot measure to reduce the number of San Francisco commissions and oversight committees, giving more power to the Mayor. CPAC cannot be eliminated because of the State mandate for LPCs. Commissions create a forum for public opinion and comment. Aaron Peskin is putting an alternative measure on the ballot.
