Welcome and Updates

Reconnecting with Committee Goals

Goal #1- CPAC engaged Mayor elect Lurie through a holiday toy event.

Sara Hicks-Kilday praised CPAC committees setting goals. Suggested increased communication between CPAC committees. e.g. Committees working together to ensure Prop C spending.

More discussion - increasing CPAC's visibility within the ECE, OST and other members of the 0 - 12 workforce is important to expand and attract new members and new leaders.

Community Forum: 2025 Concerns for ECE & OST

Discussion points:

- Find ways to reach out to the Workforce community or CPAC is always going to have the same people. CPAC meetings during the day are a barrier to people working with children, families during the day. Quarterly evening meeting?
- Meet teachers where they are; come to them. After 6:30pm on week days.
- CPAC is hiring someone to be more present in the community. The CPAC person can go to FCC, ECESF etc meetings.
- There are concerns in the community about ICE showing up. Affects attendance. School districts are sending guidance about the resources available. There is info and guidance for schools coming soon.
- AB49- Bill Text - AB-49 School sites and day care centers: entry requirements: immigration enforcement. Not permitting ICE to come into day care.

- Safe & Sound is putting together materials in one place. The City was supposed to put out a letter about being a sanctuary city, community orgs where people can get support.

- Frame the message around Mayor's priorities; e.g. higher wages for workforce = less homelessness. Better mental health.
