Welcome and Updates

Prop C Spending Strategy

Committee members discussed recent information that has been disseminated about the DEC budget and Baby Prop C funds.

- It would be helpful to have an overview of phases of funding and priorities, and when they are projected to roll out. Phases to include enhancing facilities, workplace conditions, expanding eligibility, additional support staff.
- Need funding to administer complex grants.
- Waiting for SEQUAL data has taken a long time. Needing info about an RFP timeline.

Safe Passage and Special Needs in Childcare

- Tenderloin ECE community includes Compass, Glide, Wu Yee, Cross Cultural.
- Came up with 3 recommendations.
- Extra funding for orgs – hard to retain teachers in the TL. Safety issues.
- Safe streets for children – restore safe passage that was there before. Mental health, occupational health.
